Mowing/shredding Preparation: ***Need 3**.....*

Collect fallen branches and palm fronds, cut/break up long pieces for hopper size, bag and remove large pieces for home curbside pickup,

Mulch Deliveries: *Erwin Rohrs, winter, Marcia Freeman, summer - Coordinate needs and deliveries with vendors.*

Paper/Forms Supply: *Pat Brandon – renew supply of the shed's record keeping forms, harvest bags, paper towels.*

Plot/pathway/raised beds measurement Integrity, reset concrete markers: *Tom Hopp, Ricardo Ferraz, John Jirkofsky, See that paths and plots adhere to the original design plan. Raise concrete cylinder corner markers on all plots as needed.*

Plot Name Labels: *Jill Bressler, Renew as they fade in the sun. See managers for current plot/member list.*

Orchard-Community Peach and Mango – care for 3 trees: ***Need 2***

South Shed Organization: *Cheeko Matsusaka – Storage components, Appreciation Wall.*

South Shed Tools: *Dan Dats - Periodic cleaning of tools, wheel barrows, shed.*

South Shed & Cistern Terraces: *Dorothy Tiberii - weed control.*

Storm & Hurricane Preparedness: *Garden Leadership Team* “batten down the hatches” before a storm. All gardeners lend a hand.

Tool Repair: *Ricardo Ferraz* (Members leave a note.)

Work Days Coordinators: *Garden Managers:* Schedule community work sessions.

Blue Water Barrels: *Kaitlin Kuhn, Risa Marlen.* Keep three barrels filled, clean the barrel tops.

EVERYONE

- Carry out the **small trash bag** hanging in the shed doorway and hang up a new one.
- Carry away for curbside garbage pick-up any **large black trash bags** placed just inside the entry gate.
- Pick **weeds in paths** as you see them.
- **Replace consumable items** such as tissues, gloves, small trash bags, mosquito spray, newspapers in gray bin outside shed, and such.
